Training Programme on "Village Poverty Reduction Plan" (VPRP) held in South West Khasi Hills District, Meghalaya

A total of 41 participants from among SHGs, Village Organizations (VOs), and Community Resource persons attended the programme.



Objectives of the VPRP programme were:

- To state the process of VPRP
- To orient the participants on the VO concept of seeding
- To orient the participants on the different livelihood plan activities
- To orient the participants on the consolidation and prioritization of the VOlevel plan and village-level plan





The outcome of the VPRP training

At the end of the training programme the participants were able

- To explain the concept of VPRP
- List out the different livelihood schemes of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry &Veterinary Department
- To get a hands-on practice on the various components of VPRP – entitlement plan(EP), livelihood plan(LP), public goods services & resource development plan (PGSRD) and social development plan(SDP)

- To discuss the tools of social accountability, the technical orientation of permissible works in MGNREGS and the technical verification of works
- To learn the steps and process of conducting a social audit
- To facilitate the test of the social audit process to help them prepare the findings in the form of a power-point presentation and learn about the social audit MIS and other supporting documents
- To help them document the report of the social audit practicum





The outcome of the VPRP training:

- The participants understand the concept of social audit and learned about the salient features of RD programmes
- They understood the steps and process of conducting a social audit and realized the effectiveness of social audit findings as it helps to correct the errors and pave the way for improvement in the implementation of various RD programmes

Awareness programme on Village Level Development Plan (VLDP) for village functionaries

Smt. Lizelda Dkhar Faculty SIRD attended the Awareness programme on Village Level Development Plan (VLDP) for village functionaries as resource person . The programme was held on the $13^{\rm th}$ October 2022 at Laitkroh block. The topics covered by Smt.Lizelda Dkhar included the concept of VLDP, VLDP cycle, VPRP- VLDP convergence and the 9 themes of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

The issues that emerged from the training programme were mostly related to the inability to carry out the Village Level Development Plan as per the guidelines, This was due to low participation in the VLDP plan process from line departments

- There are instances where the VLDP plan was completed in all aspects but only the MGNREGA works included in the plan were implemented excluding other plans.
- Information Education and Communication is an important aspects of the VLDP planning process. As such, there is a need to bring out pamphlets flyers and information brochures on VLDP. The BDO Laitkroh has requested SIRD Meghalaya to assist with this issue of tackling the IEC in VLDP.
